**Abortion Clinic Exclusion Zones Bill:** Penny Sharpe, Labor MLC and Trevor Khan, Nationals MLC have co-sponsored the "Public Health Amendment (Safe Access to Reproductive Health Clinics) Bill 2018." This new law would create **exclusion zones** around abortion clinics in NSW with the aim of preventing pro-life counsellors from approaching women. Penny Sharpe has **misled the public** to believe that the pro-lifers outside the clinics harass the women entering them. **This is not the case.** The pro-life volunteers offer support and alternatives to abortion to vulnerable pregnant women, many of whom are coerced into seeking an abortion by others. The pro-life volunteers offer practical support to these women, encouraging them to keep their babies. Please write to your local state MP and also to the members of the Legislative Council on this issue. Face to face meetings with the local member of the Legislative Assembly are highly effective. It is vital that we speak up on this issue.
