CORONAVIRUS: Following recommendations of the [Australian Catholic Bishops Conference](#), the following will continue to apply for the time being:

- **Holy Communion** will be distributed only into the hand (not onto the tongue or from the chalice).
- **The Sign of Peace** should be exchanged with a bow, smile, wave or nod, **not** by shaking hands.
- **Holy Water** will be removed from all fonts, temporarily. Should you need Holy Water to take home, please speak to Father after Mass.

If you are feeling unwell, please don't come to Mass. Stay home & get well!
