CHURCH REPAIRS: Scaffolding has been erected in preparation for repairs to the porch roof. Please be careful when entering the Church. Side doors are open if you prefer to enter via them. Replacement of the moisture-swollen window surrounds has been successfully completed. Also the carpet has been removed in the sanctuary areas, exposing the original terrazzo paving (1938). The exposed floorboards have been polished, as has the terrazzo in the sanctuary areas. Drainage problems on the south side of the church are being addressed.
