COVID19: WHAT YOU MUST DO WHEN YOU ATTEND MASS:

- Register name and contact details on the list in the foyer (each adult attending) every time you enter the church.
- The NSW Government recommends that masks are worn during church services.
- Use hand sanitiser before and after entering the church.
- Keep 1.5 metres (in every direction) from everyone not in your household, including in the Communion Procession.
- Holy Communion should be received in the hand only.
- Bulletins are single use only. Do not leave on pew. Please take home or put in bin.
- Do not come to church if you are unwell or have any symptoms at all.
