PARISH NOTICES CONTINUED

Parish Finances: [The Parish Financial Report for 2019-2020 is on the notice board in the foyer.](#)

It shows that the parish had a surplus of \$173,000 for the financial year, due largely to the substantial income from the rental of 58 Arden St to Everlearn Preschool (this will decrease this year due to mandatory rent relief for enrolment drop caused by Covid). Income from Planned Giving (envelopes) continued to fall, as did income from the loose 2nd collection. Although due in part to COVID church closure, the fall continues the worrying trend of recent years.

Parish funds at end June 2020 stood at \$566,766, but substantial expenditure on repairs and maintenance will be needed over the next couple of years, including treatment for 'concrete cancer' to the church front (up to \$150,000), drainage/roofing repairs to fix all the water incursion problems, provision of an accessible bathroom for the church, internal painting, upgrading lighting and sound system, new carpet. These costs will exceed our present funds.

To help ensure the parish remains financially viable, parishioners are encouraged to join our Planned Giving (which offers 25% tax deduction) and particularly to use automatic monthly giving from credit or debit card.
