COVID19: WHAT YOU MUST DO WHEN YOU ATTEND MASS:
Register name and contact details on the list in the foyer (each adult attending) every time you enter the church.

- The NSW Government recommends that masks are worn during church services.
- Use hand sanitiser before and after entering the church.
- Keep **1.5 metres** (in every direction) from everyone not in your household, including in the Communion Procession.
- Holy Communion should be received in the hand only.
- Bulletins are single use only. Do not leave on pew. Please take home or put in bin.
- Do not come to church if you are unwell or have any symptoms at all.

Parish Finances: [The Parish Financial Report for 2019-2020 is on the notice board in the foyer.](#)

It shows that the parish had a surplus of \$173,000 for the financial year, due largely to the substantial income from the rental of 58 Arden St to Everlearn Preschool (this will decrease this year due to mandatory rent relief for enrolment drop caused by Covid). Income from Planned Giving (envelopes) continued to fall, as did income from the loose 2nd collection. Although due in part to COVID church closure, the fall continues the worrying trend of recent years.

To help ensure the parish remains financially viable, parishioners are encouraged to join our Planned Giving (which offers 25% tax deduction) and particularly to use automatic monthly giving from credit or debit card.

*We offer a big thank-you to our volunteer book-keeper [David Chuah](#), who spends many hours per week on the parish accounts. His task was made more difficult this year because of Covid requirements. **THANK YOU DAVID!***

CONFIRMATION CANDIDATES & FAMILIES will be attending the Vigil Mass for [this Saturday and next](#), as part of their Confirmation Preparation program. (*Confirmation Date: Friday 6 November*).

There is an update about coronavirus on the Archdiocesan website. Although churches can now have 300, the maximum is still subject to 4 square metre rule - so we are still limited to 100.
