#### COVID19: WHAT YOU MUST DO WHEN YOU ATTEND MASS:

Please continue to Register name & contact details on the list in the foyer **OR** by using the **new QR Code**. (There is no need to do **BOTH**). This must be done every time you come to a service.

- The wearing of face masks is now **mandatory** when attending church services. (Children under 12 exempt). If you do not have a face mask please take **ONE** from the table at the rear of the Church. Please ensure you take the face mask **HOME** with you.
- Use hand sanitiser **before entering** the church and when **leaving**.
- Keep **1.5 metres** (in every direction) from everyone not in your household, including in the Communion Procession.
- Holy Communion should be received in the hand only.
- Bulletins are single use only. Do not leave on pew. Please take home or put in bin.
- Do not come to church if you are unwell or have any symptoms at all.
- Attendance at St Anthony's is limited to **100** at each service.

Today's gospel is a reminder that we are baptised with the Holy Spirit not merely with water. To be baptised with the Holy Spirit means that we are drawn into communion with God and we are also empowered by that communion to make a difference in the world—to reach out a helping hand to those in need and to proclaim the good news of Jesus through our actions and our words.
