COVID19: WHAT YOU MUST DO WHEN YOU ATTEND MASS:

Please continue to Register name & contact details on the list in the foyer **OR** by using the **QR Code** (No need to do **BOTH**). This must be done every time you come to a service.

- Masks are no longer compulsory but are still strongly encouraged.
- Use hand sanitiser **before entering** the church and when **leaving**.
- Keep **1.5 metres** (in every direction) from everyone not in your household, including in the Communion Procession.
- Holy Communion should be received in the hand only.
- Bulletins are single use only. Do not leave on pew. Pls take home or put in bin.
- Do not come to church if you are unwell or have any symptoms at all.

6TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Introduction: Today's readings revolve around healing and belief. Jesus risks touching a diseased man in order to heal him, while Paul talks about challenges of conscience in a world of differing beliefs.
