COVID19: WHAT YOU MUST DO WHEN YOU ATTEND MASS:

Please continue to Register name & contact details on the list in the foyer **OR** by using the **QR Code** (No need to do **BOTH**). This must be done every time you come to a service.

- Masks are no longer compulsory but are still strongly encouraged.
- Use hand sanitiser **before entering** the church and when **leaving**.
- Keep **1.5 metres** (in every direction) from everyone not in your household, including in the Communion Procession.
- Holy Communion should be received in the hand only.
- Bulletins are single use only. Do not leave on pew. Pls take home or put in bin.
- Do not come to church if you are unwell or have any symptoms at all.

2ND SUNDAY OF LENT

Introduction: The readings for the second Sunday of Lent follow the same pattern over the three years of the liturgical cycle. The first reading is always about Abraham. The Gospel is always the story of the transfiguration, this year in Mark's version.
