### COVID19: CHANGES TO RESTRICTIONS and WHAT YOU MUST DO:

From 06/05/2021 COVID restrictions have changed:

## THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

**Introduction:** Christ's ascension is not a postscript to the resurrection or a warm-up act for Pentecost. It is a moment of unique grace within a process beginning with the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus, through which the followers of Jesus come to understand and experience the full meaning of the unfolding of the kingdom "on earth as it is in heaven".

**Entrance Antiphon:** Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens? This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go, alleluia.

**Communion Antiphon:** Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age, alleluia.
